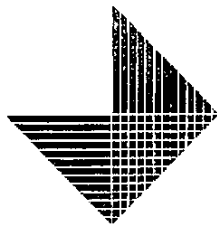

### **Mphasis revenues up 23% in FY06**

**BANGALORE:** IT and BPO group Mphasis BFL has posted revenues of Rs 940.1 crore in fiscal '05-06, a 23% growth from the previous year. Net profit stood at Rs 149.9 crore as against Rs 124.6 crore, a year ago, a rise of 20%.

## Mphasis net up 20% at Rs 149.9 crore; iGate Global profit ascends too


Mumbai/Bangalore, April 11

Financial year 2005-06 has come to an end. It's now time for stock-taking at corporates across the country to report their financials to the shareholders. Today's fiscal results by Mphasis and iGate have kickstarted that process which will go on for over a month.

Bangalore-based BPO firm Mphasis on Tuesday reported a net profit at Rs 149.86 crore for the year ended March 31, posting an increase of around 20% over last year and declared a final dividend of Rs 3 per share for the year.

The firm, which expanded its capital base after a 1:1 bonus issue during the year, reported consoli-

dated revenues for the fiscal at Rs

940 crore, an increase of 23 per cent over last year's revenue performance of Rs 765.67 crore.

Mphasis registered profit before tax at Rs 155.7 crore, representing a 38% increase over the previous year's level of Rs 112.93 crore, the company said.

### iGate Global Q4 net rises 111% at Rs 4.7 crore

Technology and operations company iGate Global Solutions (iGate) has posted a net profit of Rs 22.83 crore for the year 2005-06 as against Rs 20.79 crore in the previous year, showing an increase of 9%.

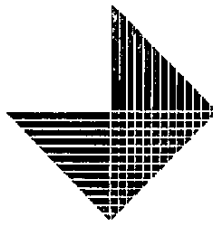
Revenue during the year was Rs 636 crore, up from Rs 580 crore re-

ported last year.

Operating profit was Rs 61.14 crore as against Rs 32.5 crore. In the fourth quarter, net profit has registered a year-on-year growth of 111%, at Rs 4.7 crore. This is compared to a net profit of Rs 1.5 crore posted during the corresponding quarter of the previous year.

Operating revenue for the quarter was Rs 167.37 crore, up 15% over revenue registered in Q4 of FY05, the company said.

Addressing the media, the company CEO Phaneesh Murthy said, "The past year saw us acquiring a promising list of Fortune 1000 clients, who will drive our revenues." ♦

# MphasiS BFL net up 14% at Rs 35.16 cr

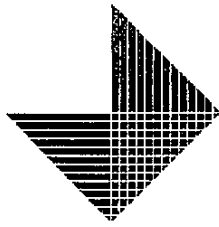

**M**phasiS BFL has reported a 14 per cent increase in net profit to Rs 35.16 crore for the fourth quarter ended March 31, 2006 against Rs 30.96 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2005. Revenues at Rs. 250.50 crore, are up 22 per cent over the levels of the same quarter last year. The PBT for this quarter at Rs. 39.42 crore, represents an increase of 34 per cent over Rs 29.40 crore reported for the same quarter last year.

Revenue growth has been 3.3 per cent on a sequential quarter on quarter basis. PBT declined by 4.8 per cent and net profit declined 13.9 per cent on account of the tax charge. The consistent profitability of the US subsidiary along with the need to recognise the end of the tax holiday in India by 2009 under Indian GAAP and the

newly introduced FBT have resulted in a tax charge this fiscal of Rs 5.84 crore as against a deferred tax credit last year. The MphasiS BFL group consolidated revenues for the year 2005-06 have increased by 23 per cent, from Rs 765.67 crore last year to Rs 940.11 crore. Profit before taxes at Rs 155.7 crore represent a 38 per cent increase over the previous year's level of Rs 112.93 crore. The net profit after tax for the year ended 31 March 2006 stood at Rs 149.86 crore a growth of 20 per cent over the previous year.

The board has recommended a final dividend of Rs 3 a share for the year 2005-06. This is on the expanded capital base after the 1:1 bonus issue made during the year. Revenues in the Software Services business have increased from Rs 481.47 crores in 2004-05 to Rs 642.15 crore in 2005-06 a growth of more than 33 per cent. PBT in this business was up 71 per cent.

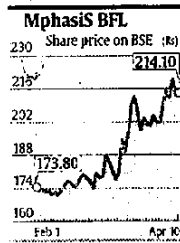

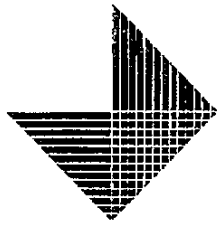

MUMBAI: BANGALORE-BASED BPO firm Mphasis has said its net profit for the year ended March 31, 2006 jumped 20 per cent to Rs 149.86 crore and declared a final dividend of Rs three per share. The firm, which expanded its capital base after a 1:1 bonus issue during the year, reported consolidated revenues for the fiscal at Rs 940 crore, an increase of 23 per cent over last year's revenue performance of Rs 765.67 crore. Mphasis, which global IT services giant EDS wants to acquire, registered a profit before tax at Rs 155.7 crore, representing a 38 per cent increase over the previous year.
