Dense Afforestation by planting 100000 trees in Doddasaggere botanical garden, Karnataka. The project aims to enhance green cover along with Bio-Diversity and aid Carbon mitigation.

United Way

Enhance the depleting ground water levels in and around Bengaluru by conserving rainwater. The goal is to conserve 200 M litres of rainwater by end of 2023 through percolation technologies.

United Way Dommasandra Lake Conservation

Rejuvenation of urban lake in Dommasandra Bangalore . The Lake covers an area of about 39 acres. Removal of silt, desilting of lakebed, walk paths, construction of wetlands, construction of culverts at inlets and outlets, formation of local community groups as volunteers, community awareness and sensitization.

Swathi BP is a fresher from Mangalore and was just out of college when she started looking for job opportunities. She had challenges very early on in the process of applying for jobs. She did not understand the sources she could go to, how to build a resume or how to prepare for an interview. She knew she wanted to be independent and financially stable, so she had to build on her skills for those reasons. She came across the Future Perfect program on Instagram and, after doing some research, decided to enroll in the program. She believed the program would help her secure a job and empower herself and her family. She said, "I joined the program to become independent and overcome financial problems."

The program started by introducing her to looking for job opportunities and reliable sources that she could explore. She was able to work on her communication and resume-building skills which would help her clear her interviews. She said, "I did not know how to look for a job and how to clear the interviews. After joining Job Coach, my coach helped me understand everything from the basics. She helped me prepare for the interview, and also, JC helped me find a job suitable for my skills." When asked about her most significant takeaways from the program, she mentioned, resume building, acing interviews with confidence, and learning workplace etiquette.

Swathi now works for Cogent Services and is excited and confident to embark on this new journey. The communication skills and workplace etiquette she learnt from FP are helping her thrive in her current role. She also mentioned, "FP is a good place to build your confidence and gain interview skills."
